Competency Standard:	Observation of practical demonstrations and practical teaching sessions oral discussions; written assessment using multiple choice, true / false, diagrammatic / graphic recognition, and short answer methods - closed book , 75% pass.
Certification:	Certificate of Attendance; Statement of Teaching Competency
Method of Delivery:	Practical demonstrations by trainer and participants, questions / answers, discussions, practical teaching units,
Resources:	In training room: Charts; massage table; whiteboard, pens; butcher paper, pens Required by participant: BKP & ICPKP manuals stated above; coloured pencils; paper; red and blue pen; personal requirements for food & drink. Provided by trainer: Theory assessment; certificate of attendance; statement of teaching competency
